

Teen Parents Involvement Requirements

Teen Lifeline Mission:

Teen Lifeline shall meet the needs of hurting teenagers by providing a safe place of acceptance, empowerment, and support.

Goals for Teen Lifeline Parents:

- Provide a parenting class once a month that will help equip teen parents to be a better parent.
- Assign a mentor to each teen mom that will be available to answer questions, remind of meetings and make Teen Lifeline aware of needs that they may have.
- Provide supplies to teen parents to alleviate some of the financial stress that comes with having a baby.
- Offer a safe place for teenagers to discuss issues they are facing.

Requirements for participation with Teen Parents:

- Attendee must be a teenager (13-19) OR be enrolled in school or in a program to receive their high school diploma or GED.
- To receive baby supplies one must attend the monthly meeting. Teen Lifeline reserves the right to make exceptions and/or enforce this requirement based on individual situations. Attendance to a meeting is defined as being present for the majority of the meeting time.
- Teen Lifeline will provide babysitting at each meeting. Children are required to attend during the meeting time.
- At each meeting participants are required to fill out all paperwork requested by Teen Lifeline. Teen Lifeline reserves the right to refuse supplies if this form is not filled out completely.
- Needs sheets are one per family and the person receiving the donation must be present to fill out and receive the supplies.
