Teen Life *Vision, Mission, and Values*

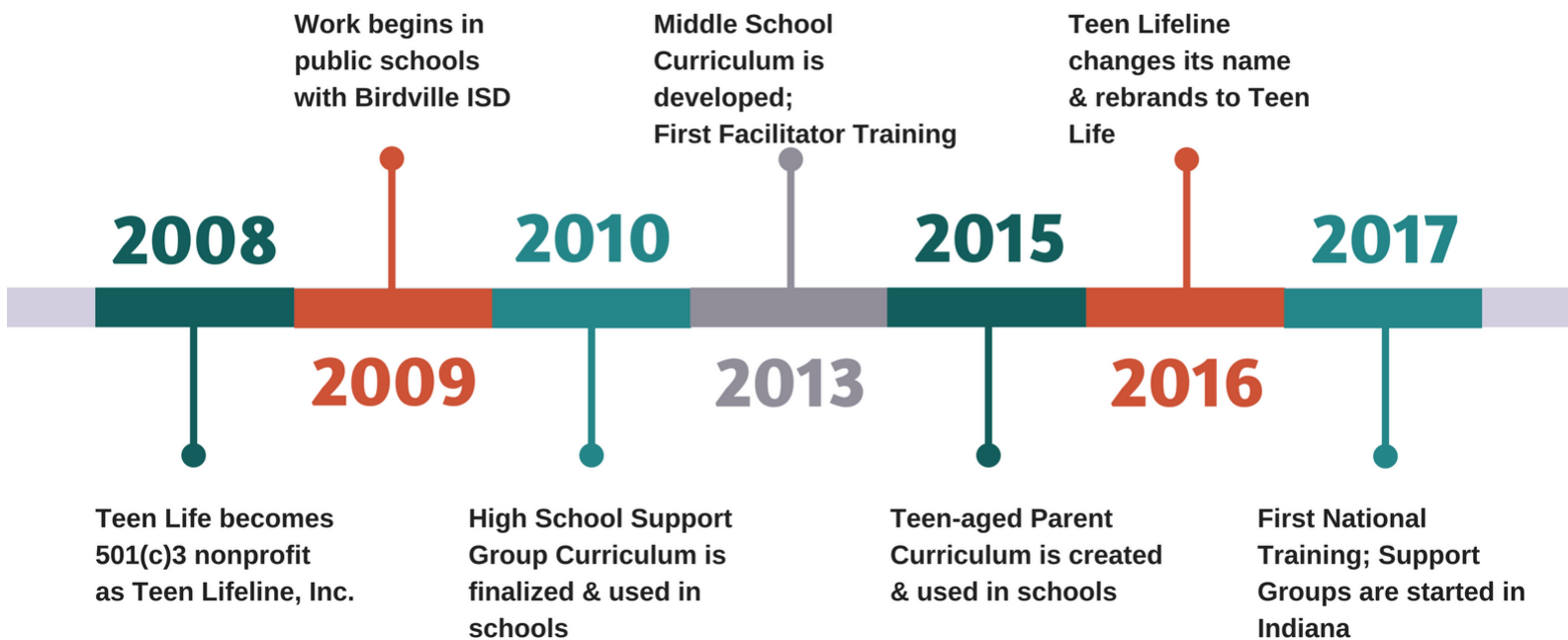
Vision: Encourage, equip, & empower teenagers to live life better.

- Our approved 2018 budget is \$415,000.
- 100% of our Board members are personally giving and, along with our staff, will actively raise funds from individual donors through personal meetings and fundraisers.
- For 2017, over \$298,000 was raised.

- Over 6,019 teenagers have been empowered by participating in a Support Group since 2009.
