Teenaged Parent Facilitator Job Description

Teen Lifeline works with local school districts and churches to identify teenaged parents in need of support as they deal with the ups and downs of life and young parenthood. These groups of teenaged parents will meet on a monthly basis at The Hills NRH campus and other potential locations. A trained Teen Lifeline Facilitator is matched with the group and will use our 10-session “Life Lived Better for Teenaged Parents” curriculum for the duration of the group.

Gifts operating in this role:

Leadership, Teaching, Shepherding

Qualifications for this role:

- Must commit to leading small group of teenaged parents at monthly meetings
- Will be given training and curriculum to lead these groups
- Ability to facilitate discussion, listen and encourage teenaged parents to ask questions, discuss, and interact

Expectations of the Facilitator:

- The purpose of the facilitator is to provide a safe environment for the group members. Mainly, you are to be an active, understanding listener.
- Facilitators are expected to prepare, gather supplies and show up each month in time to welcome group members.
- This is a 10-month commitment, but facilitators are encouraged to acquire a co-facilitator in the case of an emergency or unavoidable conflict.
