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Use this prayer throughout the week — alone, with your family, in a small group, or as you drive by schools. There is no wrong time to intercede for the students and schools in your community.

A Prayer for Students

*"I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I know that full well." **Psalm 139:14***

Father, I lift up the students at my local school today. You knew each of them before they were born, and Your plans for them are good. I stand in the gap for those who are struggling with schoolwork, with friendships, with their sense of worth.

Protect them from choices that would harm them. Guard them against addiction, peer pressure, and despair. Surround them with good friends, caring adults, and small moments of grace that point them to You. Raise up students who are courageous enough to be kind to the new kid, the lonely kid, the kid who doesn't fit in. May this generation be marked by compassion and hope.

A Prayer for School Staff

*"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand." **Isaiah 41:10***

Lord, I pray for the teachers, counselors, and administrators serving students in my community. Bless them today with energy they didn't know they had. Help them feel seen and valued, and remind them that their work matters eternally.

Give teachers the ability to connect with students who need it most, even when the day is long and the classroom is loud. Guard the mental health of every counselor who absorbs the pain of young people. Strengthen every administrator who carries the weight of decisions that affect hundreds of lives.

And where the right volunteer is needed to lead a support group or mentor a student — Lord, prepare hearts and let it be someone who says yes.

A Prayer for Families

*"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight." **Proverbs 3:5-6***

Heavenly Father, I pray for parents raising teenagers right now. The years can feel long and the days uncertain. May they find a community of support. May they not parent alone.

Lord, I also want to pray for my own home. Give me wisdom as I raise and influence the young people in my life. Help me to listen more than I lecture, to be present more than I perform. May our home be a safe haven for our family and other students. Bring connection, peace, and understanding to our interactions. A Prayer for Jesus to Be Known on Campus
